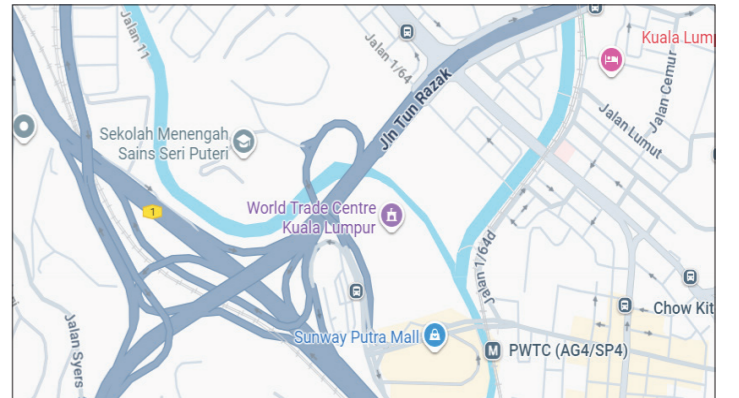

LOCATION & ACCOMODATIONS
