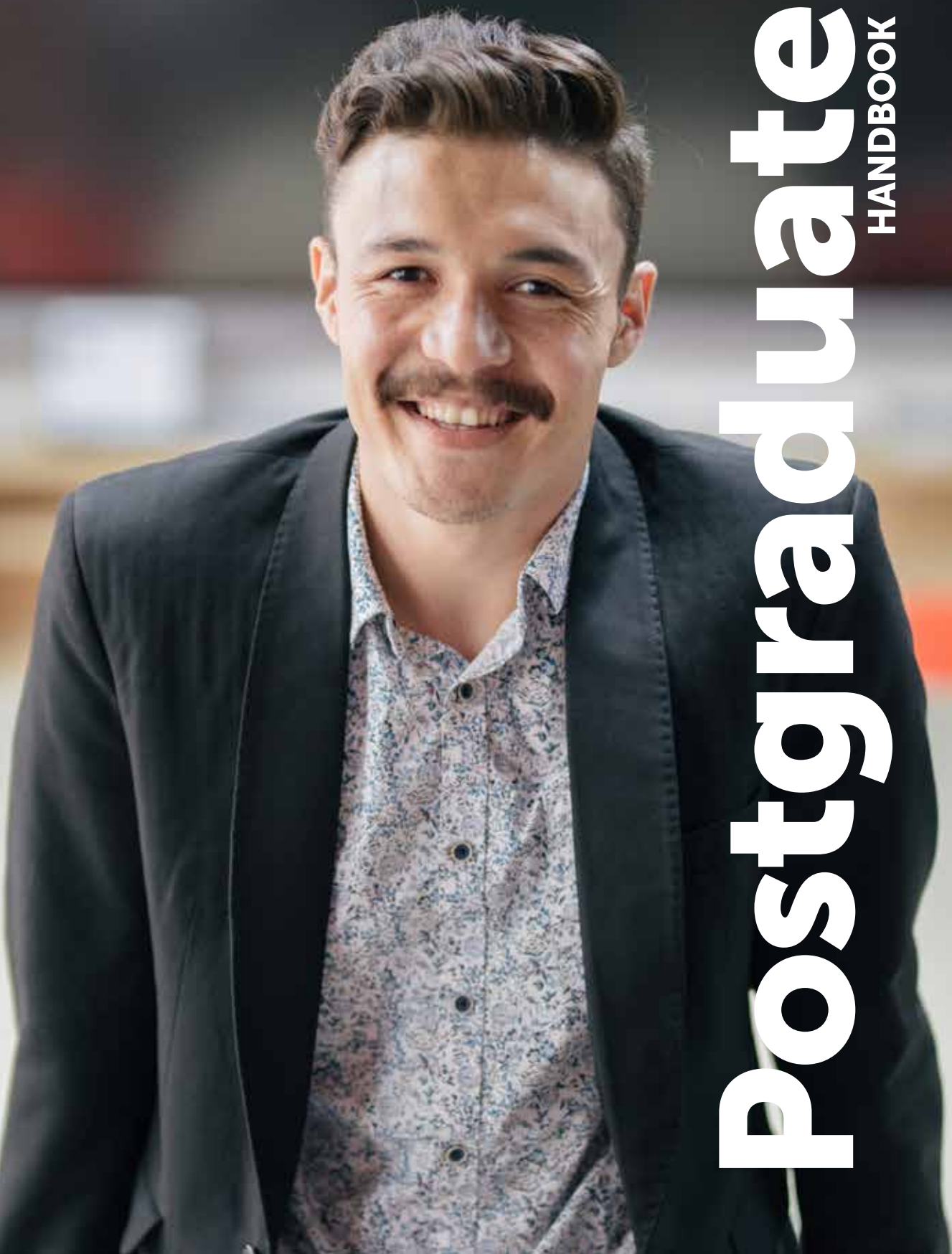

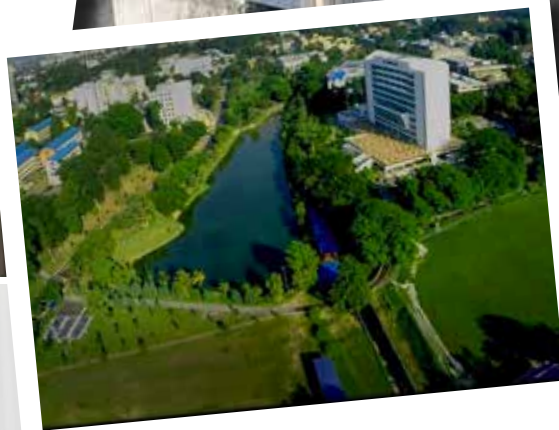

# Programme Structure

## Mode of Study

<b>Coursework only</b>	Candidates are required to acquire a specified number of coursework credits. Certain coursework programmes may require the submission of a research report.
<b>Clinical Coursework/ Clinical</b>	Candidates are required to complete coursework credits and be involved in clinical work.
<b>Mixed-mode</b>	Candidates are required to complete coursework credits and to submit a dissertation.
<b>Research (Dissertation/Thesis)</b>	Research is the principal requirement and candidates will produce a dissertation or thesis. Candidates may be required to attend some pre-requisite courses as prescribed by the University.

# English Language Requirement (for international candidates)

- Minimum entry requirements for International Candidates writing their Thesis/Dissertation in English:
  - A Band 5.5 IELTS (Academic); or
  - A score of 550 paper-based total, a score of 213 for computer-based total or a score of 80 for internet-based total for TOEFL.
- Exit requirements for International candidates following courses and/or writing Thesis/ Dissertation in other language EXCEPT English:
  - A Band 5 for IELTS (Academic); or
  - TOEFL score 500–549 (paper-based total)

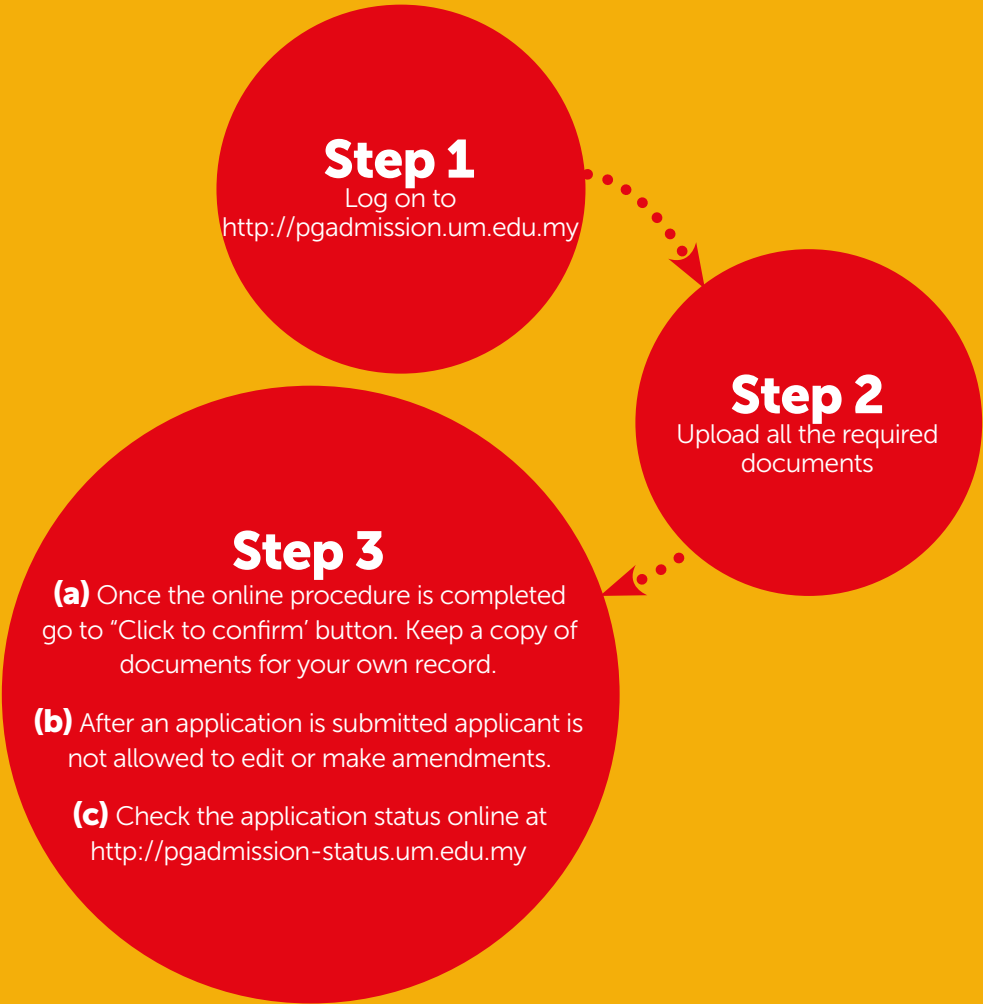
# Application Procedure

First time users will have to pay RM15 registration (RM10 e-wallet and RM5 charging fee). Revgo operates at a base rate of RM1.10 and an add on RM0.05/minute and RM0.20/km.
